 - This investment will own a wide range of managed funds and exchange traded funds (ETFs) which invest in bonds. This includes investments in Green bonds and Social bonds which directly help fund environmental or socially positive projects.

Examples of Investments

This section aims to give you an idea of the types of companies you will be investing in.



First Solar - Renewable Energy

First Solar manufactures solar panels and provides supporting services for photovoltaic power plants including financing, construction, maintenance, and panel recycling. To date, the company has sold over 13.5 gigawatts of solar generated electricity and financed and facilitated projects worth more than \$11bn.

Siemens - Energy Efficiency

SIEMENS Ingenuity for life Siemens is a large German conglomerate active in electrical engineering and electronics, with a core focus on the industrial megatrends of electrification, automation of production processes and digitalization of the factory environment. From renewable energy equipment to the more efficient transmission of power, smart grid solutions, buildings energy efficiency, lower carbon transportation and more efficient digital factories, Siemens' products address an array of environmental challenges brought about by increased global population and urbanization.

SURGICAL

Intuitive Surgical – Healthcare Technology

Intuitive Surgical is an American company that manufactures robotic surgical systems. The company has installed over 1,242 systems worldwide. It's most notable system is the da Vinci Surgical System which allows surgeons to perform robotically assisted, minimally invasive surgery like cardiac valve repair.



Tesla Motors – Electric Vehicles

Tesla Motors is an American automaker and energy storage company pioneering in the space of producing electric cars, battery storage, and battery charging equipment. The company introduced the Powerwall and Powerpack which store excess energy generated from solar panels, allowing the user to reduce their reliance on fossil fuels. In 2016, Tesla acquired SolarCity and launched the Solar Roof. The rooftop solar tiles capture solar energy, while retaining visual aesthetics and costing less than traditional roof tiles.



ResMed – Healthcare

ResMed qualifies as a sustainable leader for revenue from healthcare. ResMed is pioneering the medical industry with its array of award winning masks and machines that diagnose, treat, and manage a range of sleep-disordered breathing and other respiratory conditions and chronic diseases. The company has branched into cloud-based software applications to better diagnose and monitor a range of conditions, with over 2 million patients remotely monitored each day.



Mirvac Group – Sustainable Property

Mirvac invests in, develops and manages property assets throughout Australia across office, industrial, retail and residential. Mirvac has been a member of the Green Building Council of Australia since 2003 and has a large portfolio of green star projects nationwide. The company has ambitious goals to reach total sustainability by launching the 'House with No Bills' project which aims to develop a house with no gas or electricity bills.



Waste Management - Recycling

Waste Management is the leading private player in the US refuse and recycling market, with a 22% share of the industry. Waste Management was named to Fortune's "Change the World" list in 2015 - companies that have made a sizeable impact on major social or environmental problems. Innovative projects include methane emissions capture, next generation landfills with accelerated decomposition technology, and re-processing and recycling of older landfills.

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Management Fees

Both the Growth and Fixed Income portfolios have quite a low fee of just 0.33% per annum, which is competitive when compared with other diversified portfolios in Hub24 which charge fees of between 0.18% and 0.66% per annum.

The estimated fees for the underlying investments are also quite reasonable at just 0.79% per annum for the growth portfolio and 0.54% for the fixed income portfolio. Other similar funds on Hub24 charge between 0.15% and up to 1.275% per annum.
